

II. Plans to pay dues

A. The Southern Region has at least thirty (30) metropolitan areas where there are concentrations of Talladega graduates. You can see from the previous list many of these areas do not have an active Alumni Club. We propose to divide the southern Region into at least five (5) sections to ensure saturation of coverage regarding news of the College and to solicit support for the school and the Alumni Association. Each officer will be assigned a section of their choice to make contact with several well known graduates to encourage the local group to become a more formal organization. We will also enlist the support of the Coalition in this endeavor.

B. Each existing chapter will be contacted to encourage them to seek out additional graduates or former students to participate on a more regular basis. Each existing Chapter will be contacted at least quarterly to determine if additional support is needed from the Southern Region or the National Alumni Association.

C. A "point person" will be selected in each of the metropolitan areas if there is no local chapter. This person will be asked to contact others in the area to advise them of activities of the Alumni Association or activities at the school. That person will also be asked to encourage local graduates to participate in local and national fundraising activities.

D. Each of the metropolitan areas will be asked to provide n advance notification of any meetings, fundraising activities, etc to determine if some one from the Southern Region or the National Association can visit or participate in the function.

E. Each officer will be asked to try to combine a contact with local alumni with any business or leisure trips to an area where a significant number of alumni reside.

F. Some one in each of the metropolitan areas will be asked to serve as the point of contact to distribute and collect for any raffle tickets, etc associated with the fundraisers of the National Alumni Association.

Plans to visit with chapters

A. See D and E above. This effort will be initiated immediately after the Founder's Day weekend

B. We will enlist the services of willing participants in the Coalition to serve as Ambassadors to visit Chapters and Alumni gatherings over the next calendar year.

C. The funds available will dictate the frequency of conference calls to clubs and alumni groups to enhance personal visits and telephone calls
